

Udumalpet Arulmigu Amanalingeswarar Thirukovil

Nestled amidst the serene embrace of the Western Ghats, Arulmigu Amanalingeswarar Thirukovil at Thirumoorthy Malai near Udumalpet stands as a sacred confluence of divinity, antiquity and nature’s grace. Believed to be more than a thousand years old, this revered rock-cave temple is situated on the banks of the holy Palar River, near the picturesque Tirumoorthy Dam. Surrounded by rugged hills, flowing forest streams and verdant landscapes, the temple radiates a profound spiritual calm that draws pilgrims and seekers throughout the year.

A rare spiritual distinction of this shrine is the sacred Swayambhu Lingam, believed to embody the divine presence of the Hindu Trinity — Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva — united in a single form. Here, Lord Shiva is worshipped in the exalted form of a Guru, while Dakshinamurthy occupies a place of special reverence among devotees seeking wisdom, clarity and divine guidance.

This timeless hymn of Saivite devotion beautifully reflects the sacred atmosphere of ancient Shiva shrines such as Amanalingeswarar Temple, where nature itself appears immersed in worship.

History & Legend

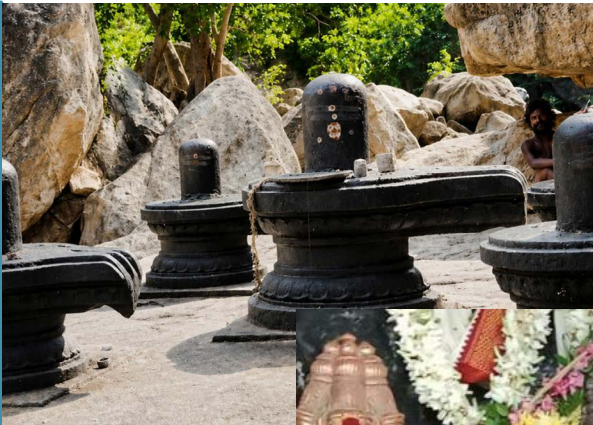
The sacred history of Thirumoorthy Malai is intimately woven with the divine life of Sage Athri Maharishi and his virtuous consort, Anusuya Devi, whose unsurpassed devotion occupies an honoured place in Hindu tradition. It is believed that the pious couple ardently desired to behold the blessings of the divine Trinity — Lord Brahma, Lord Vishnu and Lord Shiva — as their children.

Moved by the purity of Anusuya’s devotion and the austerities of Sage Athri, the Trimurti manifested themselves as divine infants and received the loving care of the sage’s household. One day, while the celestial children played amidst the hills, a gigantic boulder thundered down the mountainside threatening their safety. At that sacred moment, the Saptha Kannikas, the seven divine maidens, cast seven pieces of turmeric with divine grace, instantly halting the rolling rock.

Blessed by this miracle, the Trimurti merged into a sacred self-manifested rock form, becoming the Swayambhu Moorthy worshipped today as Amanalingeswarar. The Saptha Kannikas too are believed to have merged with the sanctified turmeric, eternally protecting the sacred abode.

The very name “Thirumoorthy Malai” is thus derived from the holy manifestation of the “Thiru Moorthigal” — Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva — who revealed themselves here in divine splendour to bless Sage Athri and Anusuya Devi.

A striking feature near the shrine is a massive rock formation above the temple bearing an inverted sculpture believed to represent a



Jain ascetic. Local tradition narrates that centuries ago, during a fierce mountain flood, the ascetic was swept down and became eternally embedded upon the rock, standing today as a silent witness to the antiquity of the sacred hills.

Deities

The presiding deity is worshipped under the sacred names Amanalingeswarar, Thirumoorthy Andavar and Mummoorthy Andavar. This temple is revered as a rare and holy shrine where the divine Trinity — Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva — are believed to have manifested together in a singular sacred form.

The temple complex also houses shrines dedicated to Sundara Ganapathi, Balasubramanian (Lord Muruga), and the revered Saptha Kannikas, whose blessings are sought for protection, prosperity and

family welfare.

Daily poojas

The temple resonates daily with sacred rituals and devotional worship performed according to ancient Saivite traditions. Besides the regular daily pujas, special worship conducted on Sunday afternoons is considered especially auspicious, drawing devotees who seek divine blessings for peace, wisdom and fulfilment in life.

Major festivals

Maha Shivaratri is the grandest and most celebrated festival of the temple, observed with deep devotion and attended by vast gatherings of pilgrims during February and March. The sacred observance transforms the hill shrine into a vibrant centre of prayer and spiritual fervour.

Special significance is also attached to New Moon days, particularly Aadi Amavasya, Thai Amavasya and Purattasi

Mahalaya Amavasya, when thousands of devotees assemble to offer prayers for ancestors and seek divine grace. The Annual Abhishekam, traditionally celebrated during August, remains another spiritually uplifting occasion marked by elaborate rituals and devotional participation.

Benefits

Among the unique traditions of worship at Amanalingeswarar Temple is the sacred offering of sandal paste. Devotees gently throw sandal paste balls towards the deity with deep faith and devotion. It is widely believed that when the offering adheres to the forehead of the Lord, sincere prayers receive divine blessings and fulfilment.

Pilgrims visit the temple seeking prosperity,

good health, longevity, peace within the family and spiritual upliftment. Many devotees also pray here for wisdom, harmonious relationships and relief from life’s obstacles, trusting in the compassionate grace of

Amanalingeswarar. Temple timings

The temple is generally open every day from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., welcoming devotees into its serene and spiritually elevating atmosphere throughout the day.
